**Eastman AAA Midget Provincial Selects of the Manitoba Midget AAA Hockey League (Male 15, 16 & 17-year-old males)**

This is a full season program requiring a head coach and general manager with the team being based out of Beausejour, Manitoba.

This team practices 2-3 times a week and plays approximately 3-games a week with extensive travel throughout the province for a 40 plus regular game season plus playoffs.

Both the head coach and general manager report directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

### **Eastman AAA Midget City Selects Of the City Midget AAA Hockey League (Male 15 & 16-year-old males)**

This is a full season program requiring a head coach and general manager with the team being based out of Ste. Anne, Manitoba.

The team practices 2-times a week and plays approximately 2-games a week with travel limited to Winnipeg and surrounding areas.

Both the head coach and general manager report directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

### **Eastman Bantam AAA Regional Male Team (14-year-old males)**

This team requires a head coach and general manager effective early September. This is a full season program with players participating on a limited basis as players play both with their club teams and the regional Bantam AAA team. Practices and exhibition games will occur throughout the region at pre designated times and arenas. There are 3 tournaments and the Rural Provincial AAA Bantam Championship with the possibility of advancing to the Provincial Bantam AAA Championship then the Western Canadian Bantam Championship.

Both the head coach and general manager report directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

### **Eastman Director's Cup Regional Male Team (13-year-old males)**

This team requires a head coach and general manager effective early September. This is a full season program with players participating on a limited basis as players play both with their club teams and the Director's Cup team. Practices and exhibition games will occur throughout the region at pre designated times and arenas. There are a number of tournaments and exhibition game opportunities capped off by the Director's Cup Tournament in late March or early April.

Both the head coach and general manager report directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

## **Eastman Female Midget Selects of the Manitoba Female Midget Hockey League (15, 16 & 17-year-old females)**

This is a full season program requiring a head coach and general manager with the team being based out of Ste. Anne, Manitoba.

This team practices 2 times a week and plays approximately 2 to 3 games a week with extensive travel throughout the province for league games, playoffs and tournaments.

Both the head coach and general manager report directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

## **Eastman Female Bantam AA Selects (13 & 14-year-old females)**

This is a full season program requiring a head coach and general manager with the team being based out of Landmark, Manitoba and playing out of the Winnipeg Female Bantam AA League.

The team practices 2-times a week and plays approximately 2-games a week with travel limited to Winnipeg and surrounding areas.

Both the head coach and general manager report directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

## **Eastman Female Bantam Challenge Selects (13 & 14-year-old females)**

This position requires a head coaches and general manager effective the beginning of February and running until around the Spring Break tournament.

Practices and exhibition games will occur throughout the region at pre designated times and arenas capped off by the Female Bantam Challenge Tournaments in late March or early April.

The head coach reports directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.

## **12-Year-Old Development Teams (12-year-old male & females)**

This position requires as many as 5 head coaches effective the beginning of February and running until around the Spring Break tournament.

Practices and exhibition games will occur throughout the region at pre designated times and arenas capped off by 1-of-3 12-Year-Old Development Tournaments run throughout the province in late March or early April.

The head coach reports directly to the Director of Eastman Minor Hockey or designate.
